Dance Place offers two types of performance contracts: **Presentation** and **Co-Presentation**. We are also considering applications for our new **Artist in Residence program**. You will need the following materials for your application:

- **Contact information** including: company name, contact name, title, email address, phone number, website and mailing address
- A **1-2 page cover letter** introducing Dance Place's programming committee to you as an artist/ company
- Title(s) of work, style/genre, number of performers, approximate length, scenic/flooring needs, audio/visual needs, desired seating configuration, and brief description of proposed works(s)
- Premiere status of work and desired performance date if applicable
- Links to **two work samples**, with passwords if applicable
 - One of your work samples should show segments of the proposed work(s) to be presented in our 2018-2019 season; if video of the proposed work is not available please include sample(s) that closely represent that work.
 - At least one sample should show a completed work (not a work-in-progress.)
 - Please indicate a 1-3 minute segment as priority viewing for the committee. Unedited videos are preferred over reels.

Please note that Google Forms requires applicants to complete one page of the application before moving on to the next. Hitting "back" on your application will delete previously entered information.

The programming committee may request a full project budget upon reviewing your proposal.
